2007 - 2008

The Tillamook Cheese Factory Project was broken up into two separate phases for budgetary purposes. In phase one, we renovated the parking lots to create a more safe and efficient entrance and exit strategy for visitors in their vehicles, which also created more parking spaces. In phase two, the main entrance into the building was reconstructed. In both phases, new fencing, wheel stops, concrete work, and landscaping was required; along with a constant focus on safety since this is one of Oregon's top 3 most visited tourist attractions. It was a hard hat zone at all times with temporary roadways and pedestrian pathways to redirect traffic and other items such as safety fencing and signs.
