The construction of this park was unique from others because of its incorporation of a railroad theme throughout the park, which included railroad themed concrete pathways in the park and play areas, along with specially made railroad interactive crossing bells. There was an interactive water feature, adjacent to a sand play area, that was ADA accessible with bronze animals mortared into the walls. The park is designed to be age appropriate for children from toddler to 13 years old and to serve special needs children with ADA compliant play structures.
